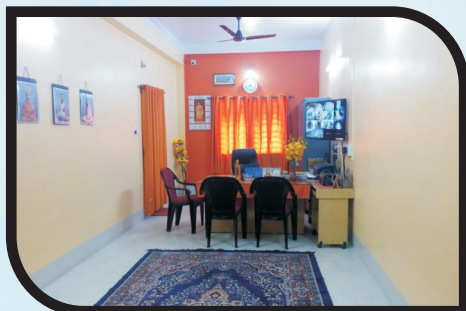
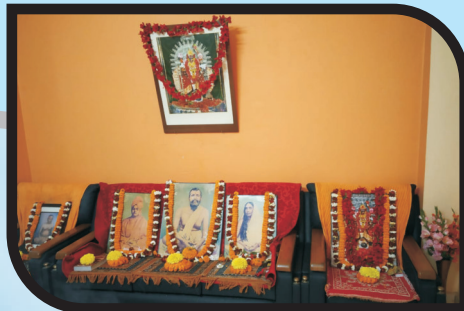
- ✱ Students will strictly adhere to the rules and regulations of the institution.
